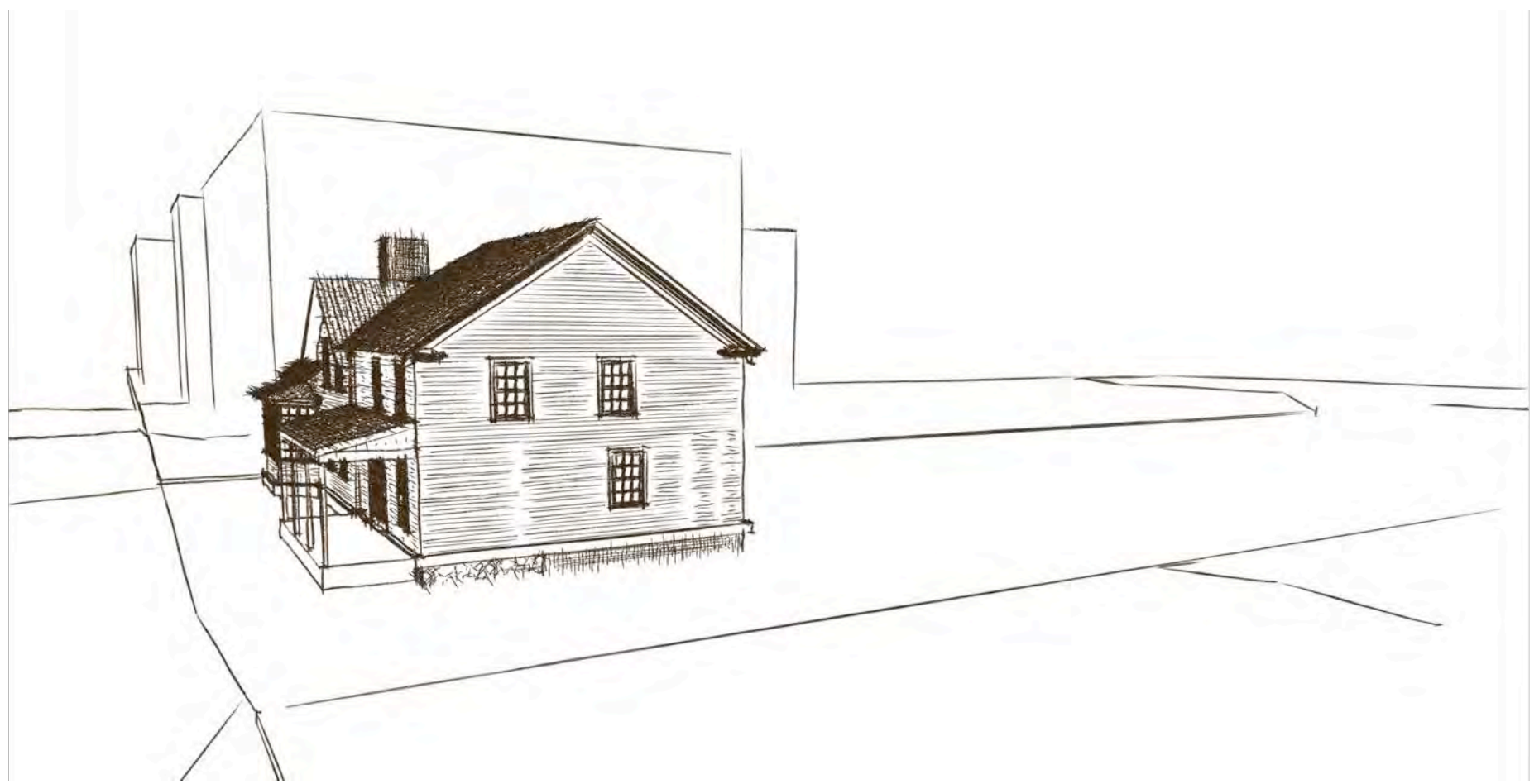

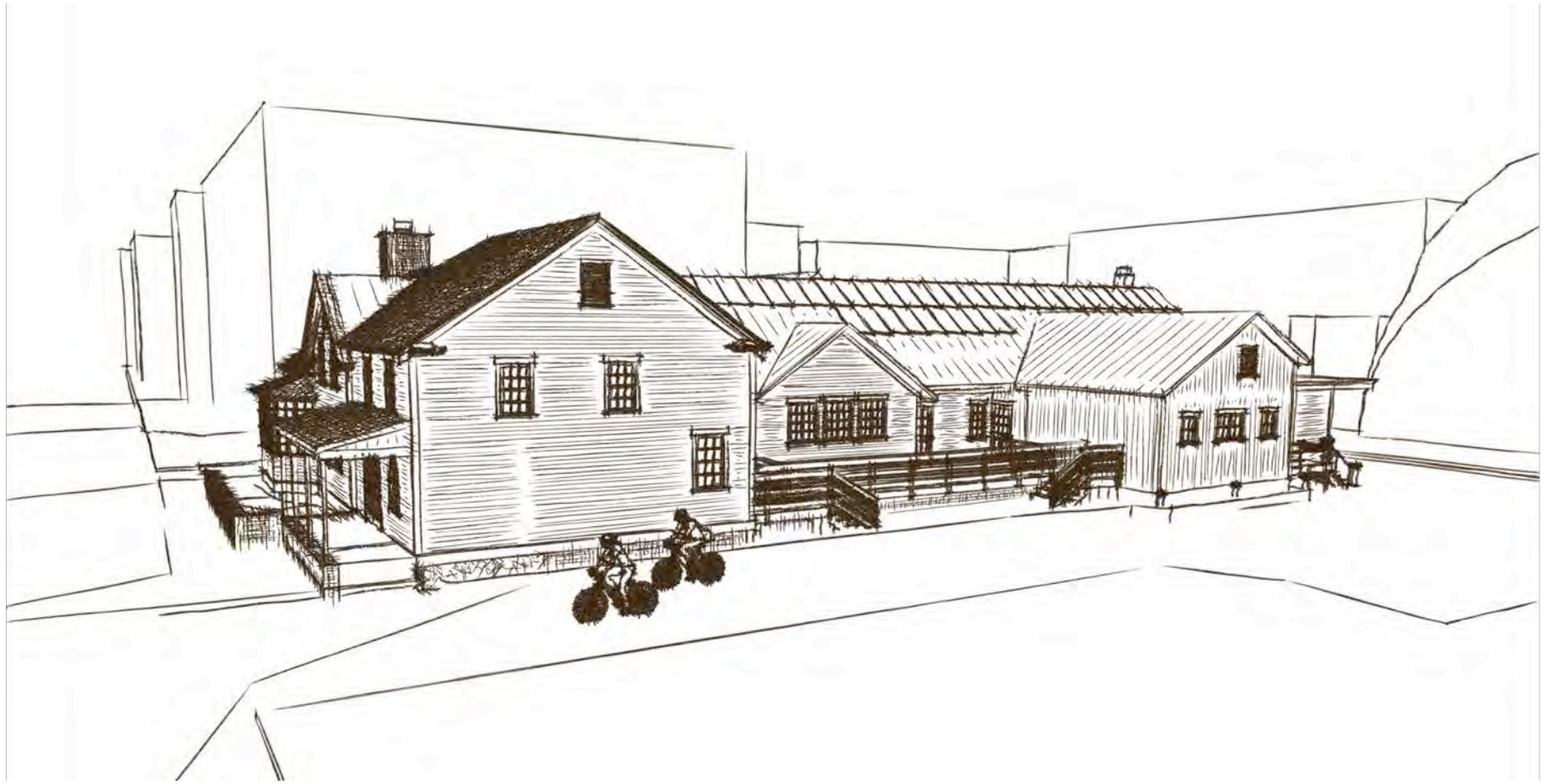

Program Goals

A revitalization project - not a repurposing, intended to enable the Log to serve its constituency into the next century.
